STANDING ORDER NO. 2/78

Subject: INSPECTIONS.

Please refer to the correspondence resting with this office No.N.8(1)Police-(A)Sec/69/4069-189 dated 19th July, 1976 (STANDING ORDER NO.18).

2. I would like to point out that inspite of clear directions, the instructions regarding conducting of inspections according to a phased programme are not being followed. It has been noticed that the inspections are rushed through in the months of February and March. Naturally therefore full justice cannot be expected to this important work. The inspections in such cases tantamounts to completion of a formality. In addition during these two months of February and March, for various administrative reasons also, it is essential that the Heads of offices are at Hqrs. to be able to handle important matters. In that the examinations of Higher Secondary and Secondary students take place in March and certain elements of the community become active and head towards fomenting trouble. Further, March being the last month of the financial year, presence of the Heads of offices at Headquarters is also essential. On the eve of the Budget Session of the Assembly which mostly takes place during these months, the political parties also become active. Dharnas, strikes and agitations take place. All these require exclusive attention which is not possible if the inspection work is not completed timely. Hence it is hereby ordered that inspections carried out in the month of March will not be considered valid for purposes of the prescribed yard stick laying down the number of inspections to be carried out by the inspecting officers. Exceptional cases, if any, will need to be specifically explained.

This may, therefore, please be noted and it may be ensured that the prescribed number of inspections are completed latest by the end of February every year.
