Several instances have come to the notice of the IGP wherein it has been found that no appeal against acquittals or revision against orders of discharge or for even enhancement of sentences against inadequate punishments have been preferred by the districts and when explanation in the matter is ~~ask~~ called for the plea put forth generally by the Ss.P. is that they consider the punishment adequate and no further action is necessary.

The IGP does not necessarily mean to interfere and restrict the discretion used in the matter by the Ss.P., but in view of the instances that have come to his notice, it appears that as a matter of fact no copies of judgement are obtained and scrutinized with a view to find out whether further action is necessary to be taken. If at all this is done, it is done in a leisurely fashion when the limitation expires. This state of affairs is most objectionable. The IGP in his inspection at Sirchi had directed that no judgement should be filed, before it has been scrutinized at C.Os. level. The IGP is constrained to point out that this direction is not observed in the spirit with which it is made.

In order that cases may not go, so to say by default it is hereby enjoined that within a week of the pronouncement of judgement in every case a copy of the judgement should be put up by the P.I. with his comments first to the C.O. and then to the SP to decide further course of action. In case the prosecution is conducted by a P.S.I. he will submit a copy of the judgement to the P.I. with his comments for necessary action.
