CIRCULAR. No. 103.

It has come to my notice that some officers have drawn arrear claims of persons serving under them for the period they were not posted to their districts. In this connection a reference is invited to Rule 167 (I) of the General Financial and Account Rules according to which bills for pay and allowance are ordinarily payable only at the Treasury of the District in which the claim arises.

Some of the officers are under a misunderstanding that they can draw such claims under Rule 169 of the General Financial and Account Rules. The intention of this rule is that arrears of pay and allowances after the date upto which drawn at the old post as shown in the L.P.C. may be drawn at the new place of posting. Any arrears previous to that date will be drawn by the old Drawing Officer and disbursed by him.

A note will have to be given in the original bills from which the claim was omitted or withheld by the officer in whose district the claim arose vide Rule 200 of General Financial and Account Rules. Similarly references of the original bills will have to be given in the supplementary bills. These cross references are not possible at the new place of ~~the~~ positing verify the correctness of the claim in the absence of the record.

It is, therefore, enjoined upon all heads of offices that they should not draw the arrear claim due to other districts in respect of persons transferred to their district for periods prior to the date of last payment shown in the L.P.C.

These instructions will not apply in respect of arrears of claim due to the fixation of pay in the new scales of pay, which are treated as special cases.
